



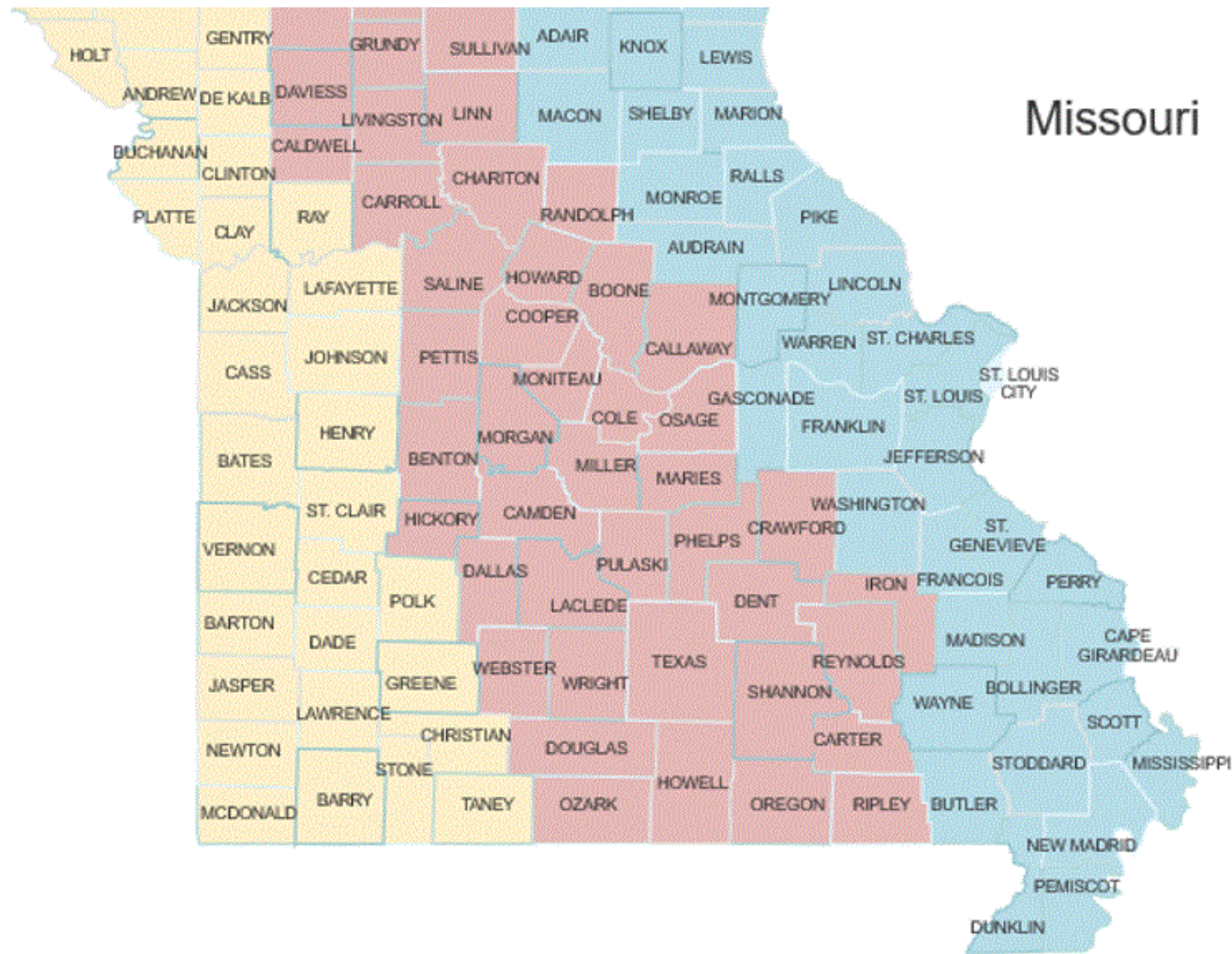

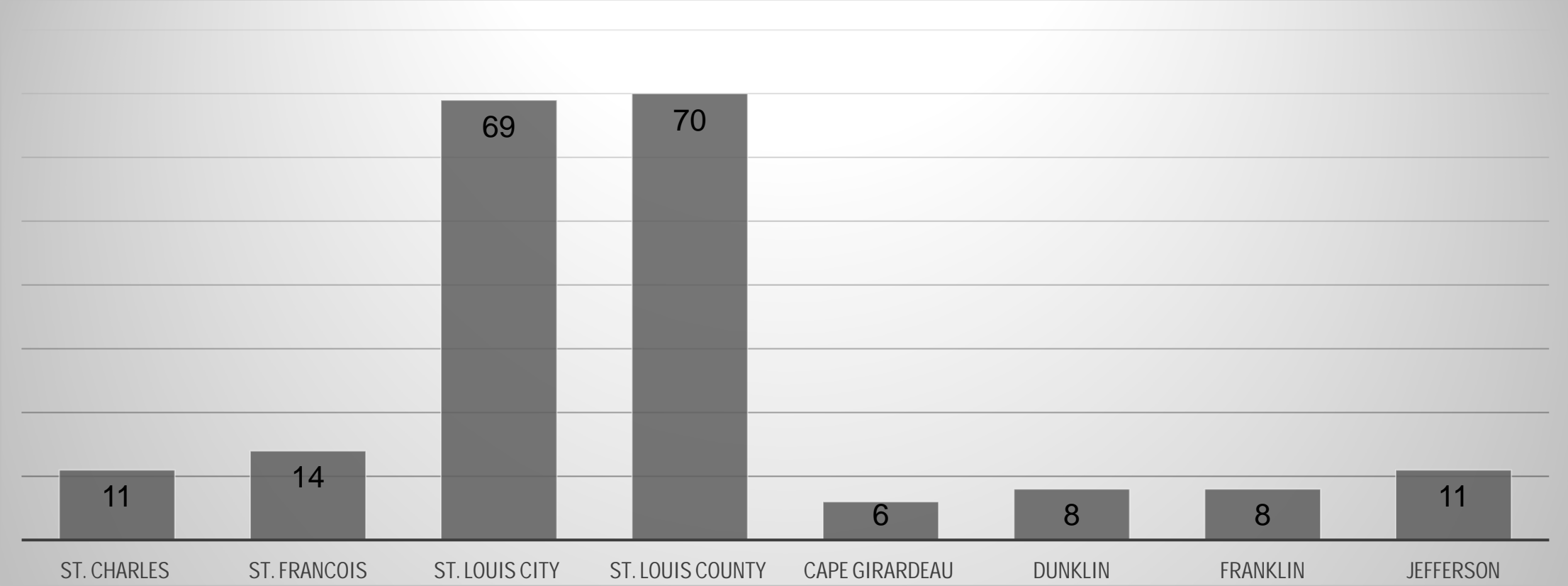


DISTRIBUTION OF SURVEYS

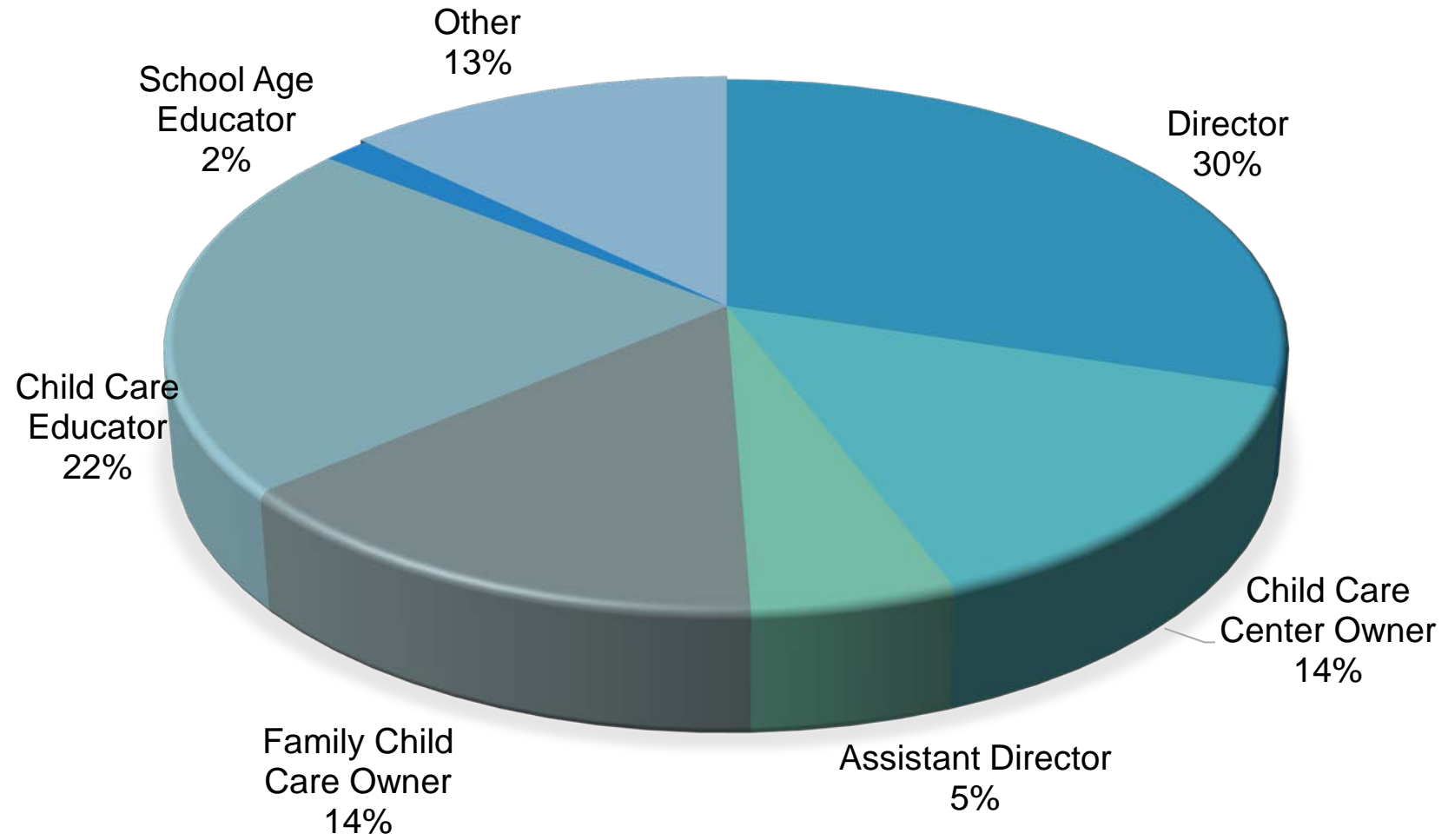

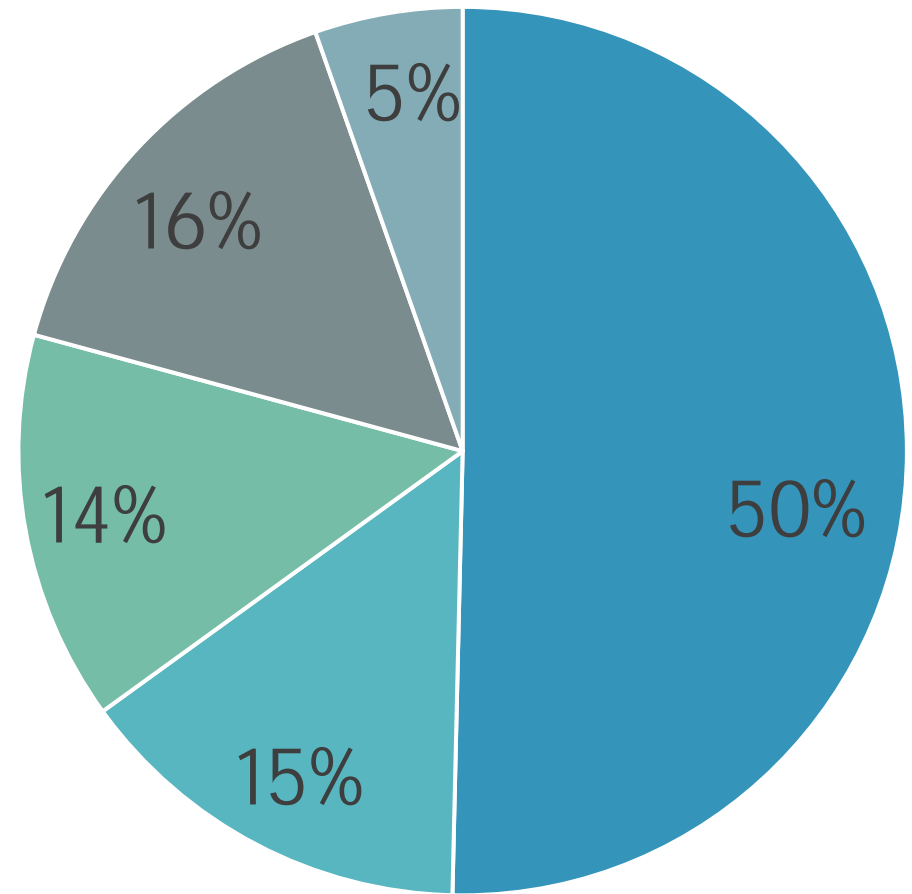

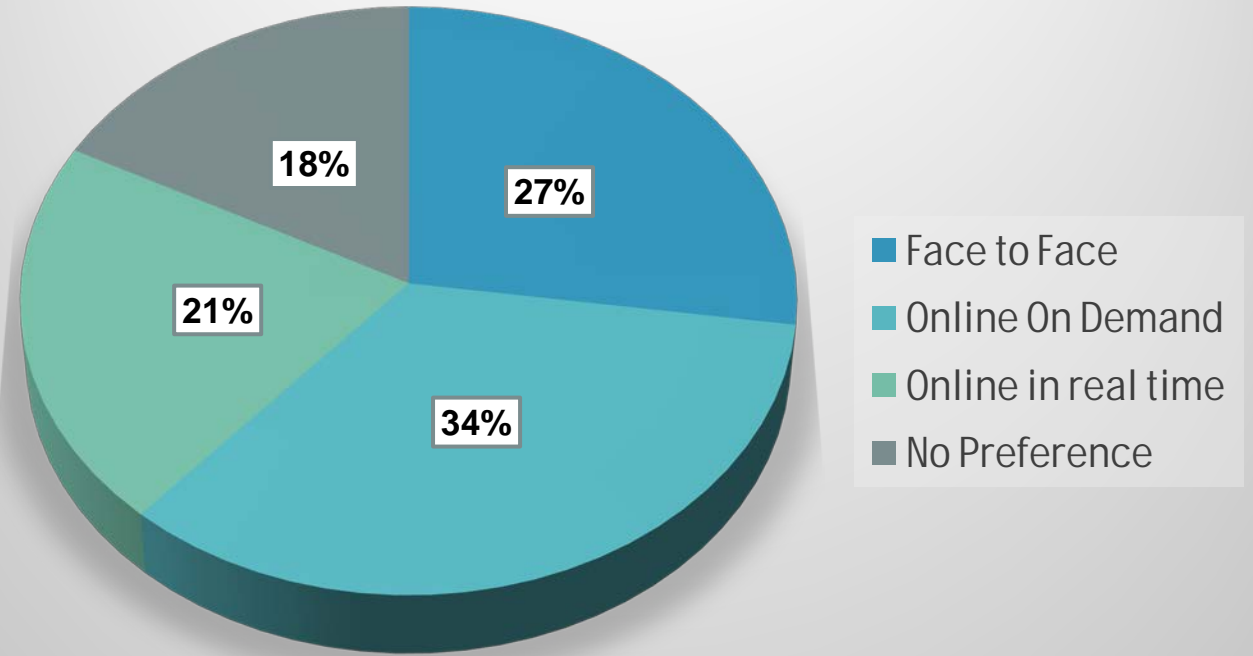
